

DELVE INTO A CHORAL MASTERPIEGE


Inspired by the Camino francés of Santiago de Compostela — the venerable pilgrimage route in northern Spain — Camino speaks of a transformative inner journey.

Camino, a unique 360-surround sound experience, uses cutting-edge technology to draw the public into the mystical and introspective choral masterpiece *Path of Miracles* by Joby Talbot. 18 speakers are dedicated to the 18 voices of the choir, amongst which the visitors walk freely. As they step into the center of the installation, their senses move from the unique timbre of each singer to the awe-inspiring unity of the whole ensemble's — offering a rare glimpse into an immersive and transformative soundscape. This groundbreaking approach to music performance reshapes the experience of the concert-goer, from traditionally passive to thrillingly active.

Practical Guide to Camino


The cutting-edge 3D recording of Voces Boreales lead by Martha de Francisco elevates the experience into an immersive sound journey through *Path* of Miracles.



Optional Units: Enhancing Features




Informative Screens

Ambient Lighting

The movement of the light is synchronized with the music, a truly multisensory artistic experience.

About Path of Miracles



Joby Talbot, composer

66 Path of Miracles is a musical pilgrimage that was three and a half years in the making.

A trip to northern Spain with my wife Claire and one year old son Maurice followed and over ten magical days (and one distinctly unmagical car crash) we visited many of the important points of the Camino including four of its greatest churches. The impressions these places left on me became the basis for the musical structure of the work.

Path of Miracles is dedicated to the memory of my father, Vincent Talbot, 1916–2005.


Andrew Gray, choral conductor

I can't think of another recently written work for a cappella choir that is so beautifully composed, virtuosic, profound, and thrilling.

It isn't often that a new masterpiece comes along for a cappella choir. We might have such a work in Joby Talbot's *Path of Miracles*. I had the privilege to perform the work, and I shared moments of such incredible intensity and profound beauty that performers would break down in tears upon leaving the stage. A few years passed, and I moved to Montreal, bringing a copy of Path of Miracles with me. Voces Boreales subsequently gave the first complete performance of the piece in North America. Shortly thereafter, the immersive installation *Camino* was born, allowing audience members to delve into the music in a more profound way than during a traditional concert performance. The chance to get as close as possible to each voice makes for a raw, transformative journey into this masterwork.

Technical Information



The entire installation lasts 90 minutes and can run continuously. The sound system consists of a set of studio speakers, combined with a high-quality standard system for support. The set-up and tear down should be handled by a sound specialist and 3 qualified and professional staff members. The set-up can be completed in 8 hours, the tear-down will takes approximately 4 hours.

Required Equipment:*

- 1 suitably powerful computer capable of running Qlab software
- 18 studio speakers, 2 to 4 ambient speakers, 1 or 2 subwoofers, and sufficient cabling
- Technical details for informative screens, ambient lighting and/or video art created by Jean Piché will be provided as needed

The equipment is not provided by Voces Boreales.

*The installation package includes meetings with Camino team members to discuss the configuration and space of your venue as well as the level of expertise of the producer's team. This close collaboration ensures the highest production value possible.
